### Step 1

Set the 1st open string using pitch pipe, piano or electronic tuner. The more the string is tightened the higher the pitch will become.

### Step 2

Hold down the 2nd string at the **5th Fret**, sound it and then sound the 1st open string. Adjust the 2nd string until it sounds the same as the 1st open string.

### Step 3

Hold down the 3rd string at the **4th Fret**, sound it and then sound the 2nd open string. Adjust the 3rd string until it sounds the same as the 2nd open string.

### Step 4

Hold down the 4th string at the **5th Fret**, sound it and then sound the 3rd open string. Adjust the 4th string until it sounds the same as the 3rd open string.

### Step 5

Hold down the 5th string at the **5th Fret**, sound it and then sound the 4th open string. Adjust the 5th string until it sounds the same as the 4th open string.

### Step 6

Hold down the 6th string at the **5th Fret**, sound it and then sound the 5th open string. Adjust the 6th string until it sounds the same as the 5th open string.

Your guitar should now be perfectly in tune!

Through time your ear will be able to recognise if the guitar sounds in tune.
